Safety and proper firearm handling are mandatory. Exercise safety, courtesy in all outdoor range activities. Members are responsible to keep our ranges clean and litter free. (Leave it better than you found it.) Rifle and pistol target frames are designed to provide an impact zone to the distance impact berm area.

## • .50 cal. BMG or equal firearms are prohibited.

### • Full Auto firearms are prohibited.

- Prominently display a current member card or FOB KEY CARD.
- Members are <u>responsible</u> for their actions and the actions of THEIR guest(s) while on club property.
- Flying the "YELLOW FLAG": range use is prohibited, unless approved by the person who raised the flag.
- Flying the "RED FLAG": red color indicates shooting range open and in use.
- The outdoor range is open daily from 9:00 AM until sunset.
- Line of Sight System: Direct line from the muzzle to the target to the distance impact berm. Nothing else in between!
- Targets are to be placed in the center between the vertical and horizontal frame work only.
- Use the Line Of Sight System to secure targets to the frame and/or personal holder frame.
- Impacting projectiles on target frame structure is prohibited.
- Only "paper or cardboard targets" are approved. Chicken Fence material is approved.
- Personal target holders used to hold paper/cardboard targets are approved. Remove personal target holders after use.
- Personal target holders may be made from wood, metal or plastic, BUT screws, nails are prohibited.
- Impacting projectiles on glass, metal, plastic, nails, screws or other similar materials are prohibited.
- The Range Dividing Berms: Impacting projectiles on the Berm ends is prohibited.
- \_\_\_\_Debris from targets /ammo cases shall be disposed of properly. Remove from property or use trash containers.
- •\_\_\_PISTOL RANGE ( Opposite from the Club Building, South side 25 yd. and 50 yd. range)
- •\_\_\_\_The pistol range is approved for pistol calibers and non-bottle neck, low velocity rifle calibers.
- •\_\_\_\_Firing line is considered the covered bench area.
- •\_\_\_\_Another firing line may be permitted: IF NO RIFLE RANGE USERS after safety precautions are **established**.
- If the rifle and pistol ranges are to be used then the firing line SHALL BE the covered bench area on both ranges.
- •\_\_\_\_RIFLE RANGE (Opposite from the Club Building, Middle range 125 yd. between the North and South ranges)
- •\_\_\_\_If Trap Range is in use: Then rifle range may be used with the Trap Event Leader's permission.
- •\_\_\_\_The rifle range is approved for pistol calibers and rifle calibers.
- •\_\_\_\_Firing line is considered the covered bench area. No other firing line is approved.
- If the rifle and pistol ranges are to be used then the firing line SHALL BE the covered bench area on both ranges.
- TRAP RANGE (Opposite from the Club Building, North side trap house range)
- Trap range users, **SHOTSHELL ONLY**, will direct shot away from any buildings and other outdoor range areas.

#### ALL RANGES

- Before going forward of the firing line. ALL firearms used at the shooting stations must be unloaded, actions open, Empty Chamber Indicator installed and placed on the shooting bench or in the appropriate storage container.
- NO FIREARMS WILL BE HANDLED WHEN ANY PERSON(s) ARE FORWARD OF THE FIRING LINE.

#### **Report any infractions to our Board of Club Officers**

#### Club President approval is required for all special club events.

Planned shooting events using the outdoor ranges allows for special targets. Setups include modifications to the general range rules noted above. Special events will have full use of one or more ranges. Special events include, but not limited to range maintenance.

- Club President (or designee) may modify range rules either for specific activities or other valid reasons.
- It is a member's responsibility to comply with current rules.
- Violations of club rules & policy is a BHR&P Club Inc. infraction.
- Violations may include loss of membership privileges
